

FIFA U-17 WORLD CUP INDIA 2017 - SECURITY ADVISORY – PROHIBITED ARTICLES



Below are the broad security guidelines in place for all the matches of the FIFA U-17 World Cup India 2017. Please read them carefully to avoid any inconvenience while attending the matches.

All Indian nationals are advised to carry their valid government recognized photo Id's and foreign nationals need to carry their passports for identification.

Unless otherwise authorized by the Event Authorities in writing, stadium visitors are not permitted to bring into, possess, hold or use in, the stadium/venue the following Prohibited Items:

1. Weapons of any kind or any objects which enable the practice of violence;
2. Anything that could be used as a weapon or to cut, thrust or stab, or as a projectile, in particular long umbrellas and other similar implements;

3. Bottles, cups (except for plastic cups), jugs, cans or any other form of closed containers of any kind that may be thrown and cause injury as well as other objects made from glass or any other fragile, non-shatterproof or especially tough material or Tetrapak packaging, or hard cooler boxes;
4. Bags, handbags, helmets with the exception of purses (not larger than 4.5 inches x 6.5 inches);
5. Power banks.
6. Remote Keys for Cars
7. Fireworks, flares, smoke powder, smoke canisters, smoke bombs or other pyrotechnics or devices which produce similar effects;
8. Liquids of any kind (including beverages whether alcoholic or not), except if acquired inside the Stadia, contained in plastic cups, and in accordance with the security proceedings applicable to the Events;
9. Food of any kind, except if acquired inside the Stadia or special food for diabetics
10. Narcotics or stimulants;
11. Materials related to offensive, racist, xenophobic cause, charity or ideological concern, including but not limited to banners, flags, signs, symbols and leaflets, objects or clothing, which could impair the enjoyment of the Event by other spectators, detract from the sporting focus of the Event or which stimulate any form of discrimination;
12. Flagpoles or banner poles of any kind.
13. Banners or flags larger than 2m x 1m50. Smaller flags and banners are permitted provided that they are made from material which is deemed "of low flammability" and complies with national regulations and standards are not otherwise prohibited under this Stadium Code of Conduct;
14. Any sort of animals;
15. Any promotional or commercial materials, including but not limited to banners, flags, signs, symbols and leaflets, or any kind of promotional or commercial objects, material and clothing;
16. Gas spray cans, corrosive, flammable substances, cigarettes, lighters, matchboxes, cigars, vaporizers, dyes or receptacles containing substances which are harmful to health or are highly flammable.
17. Unwieldy objects such as ladders, stools, (folding) chairs, boxes, paperboard containers, large bags, rucksacks, suitcases and sports bags. "Unwieldy" is given to mean all objects which are larger than 25cmx25cmx25cm and which cannot be stowed under the seat in the Stadium;
18. Large quantities of paper and/or rolls of paper;
19. Mechanically-operated instruments which produce an excessive volume of noise such as megaphones, hooters or gas-powered horns, including vuvuzelas and whistles;
20. Devices that produce laser beams, laser pointers or similar devices;
21. Powder, flour and similar substances;
22. Any large camera especially DSLR cameras (except for private use and then only with one set of replacement or rechargeable batteries), any form of video cameras or other sound or video recording equipment with the exception of accredited personnel authorized to carry the same;
23. Personal computers or other devices (including, for example, laptops and tablet PC's) used for the purposes of transmitting or disseminating sound, pictures, descriptions or results of the events via the internet or other forms of media with the exception of accredited personnel requiring the same for official use; and
24. Other objects which could compromise public safety and/or harm the reputation of the Event as assessed at the sole discretion of the Event Authorities.

Please Note there is **NO** provision of a cloak room or holding area at the venue for any of these articles that are prohibited and hence recommend not getting any of these articles to the venue to avoid any inconvenience.
